

PERFECT GAME POOL

The Escalating Perfect Game Pool is an optional event that any bowler competing at the Masters National Championships may enter. Any bowler can participate in either the Scratch or POA Pool. The Escalating Perfect Game Pool applies to all games bowled, including the Singles Stepladder.

If a 450 game has been bowled and the bowler participated in the Scratch pool, that bowler will receive the accumulated purse (all money collected since the last perfect game on both the Scratch and the POA side) plus the Scratch money from this years' collection. The high POA will win the money that has been collected on the POA side from this years' collection.

If a 450 game has been bowled and the bowler participated in the POA pool, that bowler will receive the accumulated purse (all money collected since the last perfect game on both the Scratch and the POA side) plus the POA money from this years' collection. The high Scratch will win the money that has been collected on the Scratch side from this years' collection.

If there is no perfect game, 1/3 of the Scratch money from this year's collection and 1/3 of the POA money from this years' collection will be added to the accumulated purse. 2/3 of this years' Scratch collection will go the high Scratch game and 2/3 of this years' POA collection will go to the high POA game.

A PERFECT GAME AWARD OF \$38,215.00 plus monies collected at the 2025 National Championships is waiting to be won.
